

OUR ADMISSION POLICY

Caleb University, Lagos (CUL) is a centre for teaching, learning and research, persistently ranked among the top 10 most sought-after private Universities in Nigeria. CUL embraces innovation and transforms ideas into action. Since 2007, CUL has been investing in people with the curiosity, drive, passion and empathy to positively impact their environment while also being globally competitive.

By addressing difficult issues, carrying out innovative research, and fostering a community of exceptional academics regardless of background or financial means, Caleb University, Lagos is committed to transforming the world. Furthermore, 90% of our graduates have significant plans for the future because of our extensive Career Advancement program, which facilitates a smooth transfer from education to the workplace.

The principal aim of this Admissions Policy is to offer admission to students of the highest intellectual potential, irrespective of social, racial, religious and financial considerations. Hence, we have these two further aims;

1. Aspiring to encourage applications from families, groups, tribes, states, nations and continents that are, at present, under-represented or not even represented in CUL.
2. Creating an atmosphere of equal opportunities for all applicants without partiality or bias and also ensuring that individual applicants' chance of admission into CUL does not depend on status or personality.

We consider applicants seeking admission to our University programs based on individual merit. CUL does not discriminate based on race, colour, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity or expression, national or ethnic origin, age, status as an individual with a disability, military or veteran status, genetic information, or other protected classes as required by law (cite the relevant state law).

Once students are admitted, we ensure that they are given the academic, personal and, where appropriate, spiritual guidance necessary for the successful completion of their course at Caleb University.

Once students have applied, we allow the principle of fairness in our selection exercise without any form of quota system for people from specific backgrounds. We feel strongly that applicants should be admitted on academic merit and potential to succeed in their chosen fields of study.

Detailed selection criteria vary from course to course but in all we seek;

- motivation and appropriateness for the selected course of study
- dedication and self-discipline
- academic aptitude and potential

Every applicant is considered individually in a holistic assessment using all the information available to us:

- their academic record, including WAEC, NECO, etc (or equivalent) grades and marks and A Level (or equivalent) grades of schools/colleges at which it was achieved)
- performance at interview
- the school/college reference

- performance in any written assessment

Ultimately, all admissions decisions are based on academic criteria – ability and potential – and excellence in an extra-curricular activity will never ‘compensate’ for lower academic potential.

APPLYING TO CALEB UNIVERSITY

Before you apply

You may:

How to apply

Please make sure you go through the accredited courses we offer:

- Click on the “Register” link on the APPS homepage to create an application profile and enter your profile details (full name, email and password).
- **Verification of email address**
A mail containing a link is sent to your email address to verify your email and directs you to continue with the application process. This link logs you in and redirects you to the decision page automatically.
- **Decision page**
On this page, you choose what you want to do from the three categories outlined. As a fresh applicant, you definitely would want to go with category one which has the following outlined programs for registration (JUPEB, Undergraduate, Postgraduate and CBS). If you are a returning applicant, you will want to choose from other categories to continue. This leads you to the payment page.
- **Payment**
On clicking your preferred programme, you are to make payment appropriately. Note: if you have a coupon code from any of our correspondents, kindly apply it before you go on to check out.
- After payment, check your registered email as vital information such as application code, confirmation of payment receipt and link for your application page would have been sent for you to continue to the next phase.
- Click on the link sent to your email to access your application form page and apply the application PIN to fill out the form.
- Continue with the application and in case there is a need to save your application, you can save it to continue later. A link will be generated and sent to your email to continue your application at your convenience. Note: this link will only be valid for 10 days.

- Fill out the application form accordingly and then upload the required document based on your programme of choice.
Note: Passport photograph: should be a JPG file, of 75x75px or 100x100px and a picture size of 100kb.
- Submit your application form.

After you apply

Once you submit your application, you can:

- Download a copy of your filled application form.
Note: For Postgraduate students, a reference link would be sent to your supplied referee.
- Learn what happens next if you've been invited for the admission screening exercise. Check your email for this notification and print it out.
- When you get to your admission screening centre, present your printout to the officer in charge.
